Fire Chief, Jim also reported that the fire trucks are in good operating condition at this time.

Supervisor, Tom Ziel talked about 2024 road projects. There is no news from the MREC lawsuit resolution group. There was a discussion about the planning commission continuing to write an ordinance about solar panels and battery storage.

County Commissioner Steve Vaughan reported on several state and local issues. There has been a rearrangement of the county Board of Commissioners. He also reported that there has been much talk about commercial solar development.

Bob Ross reported he is working early voting with four other Townships in the group. People who wish to early vote will have to go to the Brookfield Township Hall in Owendale. It's all new, and will cost the Township more to run an election with actual dollar amounts uncertain at this time.
